We celebrate All Saints day next Sunday (readers please note). The Feast is usually a Holy Day of Obligation and takes precedence over the Sunday Feast.

All Souls Day 2nd November

On Monday week we will celebrate Masses for the Holy Souls. The Mass at 7:00 pm is "All Ticket", only for those who have responded to the invitation to attend to, hear read out, the names of all for whom we celebrated funerals this year. As you may know, Requiem Masses are now allowed again in church (with a maximum of 30 mourners); many were prevented from having a funeral in church during the height of Covid, so this Mass will be offered especially for the repose of their souls. Please only attend if you have been invited, to respect the families of the recently deceased who are bringing two mourners. Instead, please attend one of the alternative Masses that day and/or watch online.
