All who enter the sanctuary (readers, servers etc) will need to give written consent that they are happy to appear on screen, forms in the sacristy.

We have had lots of positive feedback about our live-streaming of Masses with over 12,000 visitors from 48 countries, which is quite a staggering figure for a downtown parish church. Realistically we know that many are seeking The Walsingham National Shrine of Our Lady as many "move on" within a few minutes. However, many like what they see and stay tuned, enjoying our Masses, sometimes giving very positive feedback. We are now corresponding with new friends in Dublin, County Cork and Canada.
