### **We Are Filling Up!**

Happily, more and more people want to come to Mass on Saturday and Sunday. This is wonderful to see.

Unfortunately, in our churches space is still limited, with the ropes remaining in place until 19<sup>th</sup> July at the earliest.

Last Sunday the 10:00 am Mass at Our Lady's was full to maximum, as was the 5:00 pm Mass at St John Ogilvie's. It is heart-breaking to have to turn anyone away, but please do not be upset with us if we cannot fit you in. No need to book a place for Mass, but please remember that numbers are limited, exact number varies according to "bubble" sizes: to avoid being turned away, arrive in plenty of time.

The overflow Sunday Mass at 08:30 am in Our Lady's currently attracts about 60-70 people and can comfortably accommodate more, so please consider attending this Mass, especially if you still feel wary about being in public buildings. This is a nice problem to have, but we thank you for your understanding. Our continued thanks to our faithful band of stewards who ensure that we are safe in church at all times.

### **Flashpoint**

As you leave Our Lady's Church the door spills you directly onto the narrow roadway along the side of the church. Car drivers are responsibly driving slowly as they vacate the car park and negotiate the crowd, but we respectfully ask that parishioners take care as they leave church, taking especial responsibility for children who could so easily run into the path of an oncoming car.

### **Lockdown Rules are still in place**

Please remember to sign in via paper-slip or the NHS App. Face-coverings are compulsory apart from those exempt for health reasons. The ropes remain in place, cordoning off each second bench. Please keep social distance especially when leaving church via the second exit. Please God, come the 19th July, we can be more relaxed. We look forward to **singing** once again as a congregation.

Holy Communion on the tongue is now allowed once more, having been prohibited for many months, BUT only if the priest/minister sanitises their hands between each communicant, which is not practical the way we currently administer Holy Communion in the pews during Mass. If you wish to receive Jesus on the tongue for the next month, by which time we hope to be back to normal, please remain behind after everyone else has left Mass, making your way to the front pews, ensuring the priest knows that you wish to receive. All others, please stand, at the conventional time holding your hands nice and high at arms-length and we will place the sacred host on your up-faced hand. If you wish to receive a blessing, please stand with your arms across your shoulders.
