This is proving to be very popular, as more people choose not to carry cash. Merely tap the amount you wish to give to the parish, present your card, and “hey presto” you have paid your collection. To Gift Aid, merely type in your details (this can take a minute or two, so do it when there is not a queue. The machine should store your Gift Aid details, so you only have to give them once.
