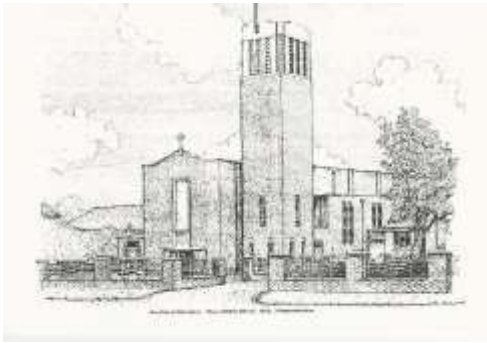

Pentecost

As you have no doubt heard, today the Bishops of England and Wales have reintroduced the Sunday Obligation for all Catholics. After two years, now is the time to gently ease yourself back into attending Mass, following the Pandemic which made it impossible for us to attend. Most have returned by now and it is great to see our churches full again, some are understandably still reticent and possibly worried. Some parishes have decided to cease broadcasting their Masses livestream, especially as we have First Holy Communions. We will however no longer read out the Act of Spiritual Communion.

In most ways we are back to pre-Covid 'normal', although I think it will be some time until we reintroduce the Chalice for Holy Communion of the Precious Blood and we will continue the sign of peace with a reverent bow rather than a handshake. Hand sanitiser is highly recommended and face coverings remain voluntary although highly encouraged.

For those who are sick, travelling or caring for someone who is sick, exception to attend Mass continues to apply as was always the case. For now, we will retain the 08:30 am Sunday Mass which was only introduced during Covid to create more "elbow room".
