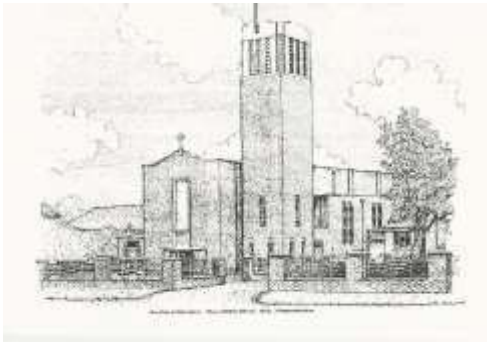

Please remember that until the new priest comes, we will have limited priestly resources as Canon Michael splits his time between the demands of our parishes and of the Diocese. Let us pray that the new priest will come soon.

First Holy Communion

This Sunday is the turn of Evelina and Mukudzei who receive Jesus for the first time in the Eucharist during the Sunday Mass. Blessings upon their young heads.

These two children bring the First Holy Communions to a close for this year. Almost eighty, yes 80, children have been involved on Sundays since Easter. Next year we will revert to the conventional one-day celebration, usually in May or June, when all the children make their Communion together.
