The Prayer to St Michael the Archangel

(see below) is now a staple of liturgies in many parishes across the world either as part of the Holy Rosary and/or often recited after the conclusion of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. This prayer, invoking the assistance of the Archangel Michael, has been offered by the clergy and laity since AD 1886 (composed as it

was by Pope St Leo XIII), but its popularity declined following the Second Vatican Council (October 1962 to December 1965). However, renewed interest in the prayer developed in the autumn of AD 2018 in the wake of concerns about unity within the Catholic Church and new revelations of sexual abuse of minors and adolescents by clergy and others. In October of that year, Pope Francis invoked the prayer and suggested it be recited by all the faithful. The Holy Father has not been shy in citing the devil as a cause of evil and disunity: "[The church must be] saved from the attacks of the malign one, the great accuser and at the same time be made ever more aware of its guilt, its mistakes, and abuses committed in the present and the past" (29th September AD 2018). The prayer was also endorsed by Pope St John Paul II in a 1994 *Angelus* address as he reflected on threats toward the unborn.

Holy Michael the Archangel, defend us in this day of battle. Be our safeguard against the wickedness and snares of the devil. May God rebuke him, we humbly pray, and do thou, O Prince of the heavenly host, by the power of God, thrust down into hell satan, and all evil spirits, who wander through the world for the ruin of souls. Amen
