There will be a **Second Collection this weekend** to support the important work of the Mission Directorate.



on Sunday, 24th September is a wonderful opportunity to seek Mary's intercession for Corby and its surrounding villages.



In this **Novena** we turn to **Our Lady** of Walsingham and ask of her pravers in our time of need and in preparation for our forthcoming Parish Solemnity. Seeking Mary's prayers is an integral part of our Faith; we turn to Mary as her children, recalling that in His dving breath Jesus

entrusted us into his Mother's maternal care (John 19:26-27). When in 1061 Our Lady appeared to Richeldis she asked that a replica of the Holy House be built in Walsingham as a memorial to the Annunciation; following its destruction at the English Reformation we might now consider the Marian side chapel at OLW as a *new* Holy House! As we approach our great Patronal Solemnity may we trust anew in Mary's powerful intercession for us and let us also recall that in 1897 Pope Leo XIII said:

"When England goes back to Walsingham, Our Lady will come back to England".
