New Lectionary for England and Wales:

This new Lectionary, which includes the Sacred Scripture readings for Mass and the sacraments, will come into use in England and Wales from Advent AD 2024. The translation of the sacred texts is the English Standard Version (Catholic Edition) along with the Abbey Psalms and Canticles and the books will be produced by the Catholic Truth Society. The introduction of the new Lectionary will provide an opportunity for catechesis regarding how we encounter Christ in the reading and proclamation of the Sacred Scriptures. Still further, it will help readers to perform this important liturgical role on behalf of the whole community. We shall also be encouraged to observe a brief period of silence after each reading so as to take the word of God to heart. This is therefore the perfect opportunity to thank everyone who reads the Sacred Scriptures at Mass and thus enables us as a community of Faith to hear and respond to the voice of God.

This weekend is a fantastic opportunity for us to seek Mary's loving intercession for Corby and its surrounding villages.

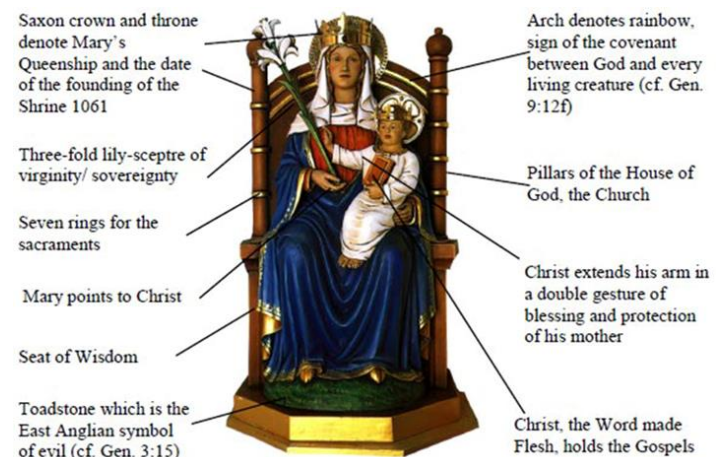
