Now is the time to enrol your child for our parishes:

Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion Course

Children must be in School Year 3 and over.

Sacrament of Confirmation Course

Children must be in School Year 6 and above.

To enrol on the above courses, please email the parish office: parish.ourladyofwalsingham@northamptondiocese.org and clearly state that you want to enrol your child for either: "First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion" course or the "Sacrament of Confirmation" course.

We will add your child's name to the list and inform you about what happens next in due course. Participation every Sunday in Holy Mass, in either of our churches, is compulsory.

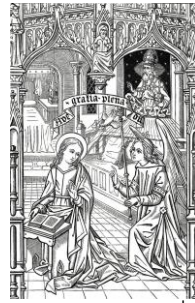
Did you know that it is canonical necessity that a Sunday Mass be offered for the parish ("*Pro Populo*") each week?

A **Rorate Caeli Mass** is often celebrated just before dawn in Advent in honour of Our Lady.
