Autumn 2023 Plenary Resolutions from the Catholic Bishops of England and Wales:

- Synod on Synodality Steps towards renewal 1: "Echoing our Holy Father's sentiments, we invite every parish, school, and community to look anew at how the adoration of the Lord, not least through Eucharistic Adoration, and the service of the Lord in people in need, can be better connected and reinvigorated. This deeper relationship with the Lord will enable us to embrace what emerges from the second part of the Synod Assembly taking place in October 2024."
- Synod on Synodality Steps towards renewal 2:

 "Following Pope Francis's invitation, we invite Catholics in
 England and Wales to consider these questions see the
 noticeboard in Church as an intermediate step towards
 taking an active part in the synodal renewal. With the
 Lord Jesus at the centre, our pathway is one of joyful faith
 which seeks to bring the Gospel alive in daily life."
- Environmental Concerns: "[We] welcome Pope Francis's Apostolic Exhortation, Laudate Deum. We ask Catholics to consider how they can respond to the Pope's urgent call to action by deepening their relationship with Christ and, through doing so, resolve to undertake and promote practical action to respect and nurture God's creation and the natural world" (abbreviated).
- Shrine of St Winefride, Holywell: "[We] approve the elevation of the Diocesan Shrine of St Winefride, Holywell to the status of National Shrine for England and Wales." St Winefride: Pray for us.
- National Eucharistic Congress: "[We] commit to supporting the National Eucharistic Congress at Oscott College in September 2024, encouraging at least one coach to attend from each diocese."
- Conflict in Israel and Gaza: "...we deplore and condemn
 the barbaric terrorist attacks perpetrated in Israel on 7th
 October 2023. We weep for the innocent victims of
 violence, especially the children, whose lives are
 traumatised by the escalation of violence in the region.
 We pray earnestly that the regional instabilities created
 will not lead to a wider conflict, fuelled by anti-Semitism,
 xenophobia and terrorism."
