### The Bishops Synod on Synodality Resolutions:

### • Steps towards renewal 1:

Echoing our Holy Father's sentiments, we invite every parish, school, and community to look anew at adoration of the Lord, not least through \*Eucharistic Adoration... This deeper relationship with the Lord will enable us to embrace what emerges from the Synod Assembly in October 2024.

\*Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will take place on the Satudays of Advent (see calendar for details).

### • Steps towards renewal 2:

Renewal requires ongoing conversion, personally and in our communities. The themes of communion, participation and mission have helped us formulate important questions which we invite every Catholic in England and Wales to consider:

- How can we create and promote space and time for prayer, for spiritual communion, for adoring God, and for listening and responding to God?
- 2. How can we deepen and broaden opportunities for people to participate in the prayer of adoration, linking this to the service of others?
- 3. How do we encourage greater participation in the synodal process at the local level, including further reflection on the Synodal Synthesis?
- 4. How can our experiences of prayer, of thirsting and longing for God, and of gratitude and wonder, give a missionary witness and invitation that is attractive to others?
- 5. How can the person of Christ be clearly seen at the heart of the service we offer?
- 6. How can our service to people in need be framed and shaped to increase the widest possible participation?
