Sacrament of Confession: The Bishops have asked that neither the Priest nor Penitent take a mobile phone into the Confessional. *The Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1992:*

- "The forgiveness of sins committed after Baptism is conferred by a particular sacrament called the sacrament of conversion, confession, penance, or reconciliation." #1486
- "Individual and integral confession of grave sins followed by absolution remains the only ordinary means of reconciliation with God and with the Church." #1497

The lovely Advent tradition of *Bambinelli Sunday* was instituted by Pope St John Paul II and is observed on the Third Sunday of Advent: *Gaudete Sunday*. Parishes across the world now join in this celebration by encouraging people to bring to Mass their image of the Infant Jesus to be blessed anew on this particular Sunday; thus, also making the connection between their home Nativity Set and the local Catholic parish. Do bring your image of Baby Jesus to Mass next Sunday to be blessed!
