This is what the Holy Father had to say about this Year of Prayer: "In a word, may it be an intense year of prayer in which hearts are opened to receive the outpouring of God's grace and to make the 'Our Father', the prayer Jesus taught us, the life programme of each of his disciples." The Jubilee Year is a special time of grace in which the Church offers the possibility of obtaining a plenary indulgence, that is, the full or partial removal of the temporal punishment associated with sin so that no further expiation in Purgatory is required; this can be either for oneself or for the departed.
