This Sunday is **Mothering Sunday!** Its name derives from the words of St Paul and the Entrance and Communion Antiphons which we hear at Mass; these speak of the new heavenly city of Jerusalem, which is likened to being our mother.

St Joseph is closely associated with the colour green as this symbolises his faithfulness to God's call. **St Joseph: Pray for us.**

The **Litany of St Joseph** will be offered, for our parishes, after Mass from Sunday, 10th March for nine consecutive days.

St Joseph and Pope Francis: In commemoration of the 150th anniversary of the declaration of St Joseph as the Patron of the Universal Church, Francis proclaimed a "Year of St Joseph". The Pope has had a great devotion to St Joseph for many years; elected to the Papacy on 13th March 2013 he chose St Joseph's Day (19th March) as the date of his installation as Bishop of Rome. He has shared with us that he keeps a statue of the sleeping St Joseph in his room and for decades has offered a daily prayer to this saint. St Joseph was added to the Second, Third and Fourth Eucharistic Prayers (only) by Pope Francis in 2013; Pope John XXIII had included St Joseph in the First Eucharistic Prayer in 1962.

On the **Solemnity of St Joseph 2020** Bishop David was ordained as Bishop of Northampton in our Cathedral Church.
