St Joseph - A Papal Saint: If we look closely at the Holy Father's coat of arms, we see that St Joseph is represented by the

"spikenard" flower; from which is derived both a fragrant oil (which links us to Jesus' burial) and incense (a reminder of Christ's divinity).



Had today not been a Sunday in Lent we would be celebrating (the Feast of):



We especially assure our Irish and Nigerian parishioners and all with such ancestry of our prayers on this day. We also pray today for the parish of St Patrick, Corby. Born in AD 385, most likely in Wales, and given the name Maewyn Succat, he changed his name to Pātricius (Patrick) on his Ordination as a Priest. Maewyn was captured by Irish pirates at the age of sixteen and was sold as a slave.

At the age of twenty-two Maewyn escaped

his bondage and returned to Britain; he subsequently returned to Ireland with the permission of Pope Celestine and there built on the missionary work of Palladius. The oldest depictions of Patrick show him clothed in blue vestments. St Patrick: Pray for us.

Blessing of Easter Baskets - Święconka

This will take place at 12:00noon on Holy Saturday (30th March) in OLW Church and all are very welcome to participate in this. The various traditional items in the baskets have a symbolic meaning:

- Bread: recalls Christ's institution of the Mass.
- Lamb: represents Jesus' sacrifice as the Lamb of God.
- Salt: symbolises our need to be "the salt of the earth".
- Horseradish: symbolic of Jesus' bitter Passion and Death.
- Wine: represents the Blood of Christ shed at Calvary.
- Decorated hardboiled eggs: symbolise Jesus' resurrection.
- Ham: symbolic of the abundance of grace in Eastertide.
- Candle: represents Christ as the "Light of the World".

The basket is covered in a cloth to symbolise the shroud in which Christ was wrapped after His death and in which He was buried.
