Thank you to all who participated in Mass on St Joseph's Day and congratulations to those who were invested with the green scapular. *Remarkably 120 votive candles were lit at the statue of St Joseph!* The "Miniature St Joseph's Cord" sacramental - which is an outward prayer for spiritual strength, humility and chastity - will be celebrated on Wednesday, 1st May (details to follow).

A gentle reminder that the Priest alone offers the concluding doxology of the Eucharistic Prayer (that is: "Through him, and with him, and in him...") but everyone is strongly encouraged to join in the singing or saying of the Great Amen at the conclusion.

Life in the Spirit Seminars: These are being held in OLW and Northampton Cathedral. See previous newsletter for details.

Blessing of Easter Baskets: This is open to everyone! See the calendar for details. Items to include in the basket:

- Bread: to recall Christ's institution of the Mass.
- Lamb: to represent Jesus' sacrifice as the Lamb of God.
- Salt: to symbolise our need to be "the salt of the earth".
- Horseradish: to symbolise Jesus' bitter Passion and Death.
- Wine: to represent the Blood of Christ shed at Calvary.
- Decorated hardboiled eggs: to symbolise Jesus' resurrection.
- Ham: to symbolise the abundance of grace in Eastertide.
- Candle: to represent Christ as the "Light of the World".

The basket is covered in a cloth to symbolise Jesus' death shroud.

Jesus: I trust in you! St Faustina: Pray for us.

Jesus said to St Faustina:

- "I desire that during these nine days you bring souls to the fountain of My mercy, that they may draw...strength and refreshment...in the hardships of life, and especially at the hour of death". St Faustina's Diary, 1209.
- "For them [poor sinners] I dwell in the tabernacle as King of Mercy". St Faustina's Diary, 367.

The **Divine Mercy Novena** will be offered each day:

- At 6:00pm on Good Friday (29th March) in OLW.
- At 12:00noon on Holy Saturday (30th March) in OLW.
- After the 8:30am Mass on Easter Sunday (31st March).
- After the daily Mass until Saturday, 6th April.

Devotion to the Divine Mercy is based on the writings of St Faustina and focuses on the grace poured forth in Christ's passion, death and resurrection and thus the forgiveness of sin. Divine Mercy Sunday is the focus of our acceptance of Jesus' mercy and therefore "the faithful should be taught to understand this devotion". *Directory on Popular Piety and the Liturgy, 154*
