Jesus said to St Faustina:

- "I desire that during these nine days you bring souls to the fountain of My mercy, that they may draw...strength...in the hardships of life". *St Faustina's Diary, 1209*
- "For them [poor sinners] I dwell in the tabernacle as King of Mercy". *St Faustina's Diary, 367*

The **Divine Mercy Novena** will be offered each day:

- After the 8:30am Mass on Easter Sunday (31st March).
2002 Vatican instruction: On Divine Mercy Sunday Priests should lead the recitation of the Divine Mercy prayers.
- After the daily Mass until Saturday, 6th April.

Devotion to the Divine Mercy Jesus is based on the writings of St Faustina and focuses on the grace poured forth in Christ's passion, death and resurrection and thus "**the faithful should be taught to understand this devotion**" in order to obtain the associated grace. *Directory on Popular Piety and the Liturgy, 154*
