The miniature **St Joseph's Cincture** sacramental will be celebrated during Mass on **Wednesday, 1st May:** The Memorial of St Joseph the Worker

The Cincture of St Joseph dates to 1657 when a nun in Antwerp named Sister Elizabeth received a miraculous healing after beginning to wear a rope in honour of St Joseph. The **St Joseph's Cincture** is akin to the one worn by a Priest at Mass,

by monks and nuns plus Consecrated Virgins as a sign of their call to chastity. In AD 1859 the devotion was officially recognised by the Church and Pope Pius IX enriched it with indulgences. There are five elementary graces attached to this wonderful devotion:

- 1: St Joseph's protection.
- 2: Purity of soul.
- 3: The grace of chastity.
- 4: Final perseverance.
- 5: Assistance at the hour of death.

The large **St Joseph's Cincture** is worn on one's body whereas the miniature version is carried in a pocket or placed before a statue of the saint at home. Those who undertake this pious act are to daily offer one *Gloria Patri* ("Glory be...") on each of the seven knots of the cincture while pondering the "Seven Sorrows and Seven Joys" (more details to follow in future newsletters).

We have commissioned 25 **miniature St Joseph's Cinctures** and so we ask for a £4.50 donation to cover costs. You can reserve your miniature St Joseph's Cincture by contacting Maggie at the Parish Office. Payment for the cincture can be made after Mass on 1st May (when they will be blessed using the official formula).
