The miniature **St Joseph's Cincture** sacramental will be celebrated on **Wednesday, 1st May** at Holy Mass: The Memorial of St Joseph the Worker

The Cincture of St Joseph dates to 1657 when a nun in Antwerp named Sister Elizabeth received a miraculous healing after beginning to wear a rope in honour of St Joseph. The **St Joseph's Cincture** is akin to the one worn by a Priest at Mass,

by monks and nuns plus Consecrated Virgins as a sign of their call to chastity. In AD 1859 the devotion was officially recognised by the Church and Pope Pius IX enriched it with indulgences. There are five elementary graces attached to this wonderful devotion:

- 1: St Joseph's protection.
- 2: Purity of soul.
- 3: The grace of chastity.
- 4: Final perseverance.
- 5: Assistance at the hour of death.

The miniature **St Joseph's Cincture** is carried in a pocket or placed before a statue of the saint at home. Those who undertake this pious act are to daily offer one *Gloria Patri* ("Glory be...") on each of the seven 'knots' of the cincture while pondering the:

The Seven Sorrows of St Joseph:

- 1: The doubt of Saint Joseph - Matthew 1:19.
- 2: The poverty of Jesus' birth - Luke 2:7.
- 3: The Circumcision - Luke 2:21.
- 4: Simeon's prophecy that many would be lost - Luke 2:34.
- 5: The flight into Egypt - Matthew 2:14.
- 6: The return from Egypt - Matthew 2:22.
- 7: The loss of the Child Jesus - Luke 2:45.

The Seven Joys of St Joseph:

- 1: The Message of the Angel - Matthew 1:20.
- 2: The Birth of Jesus - Luke 2:7.
- 3: The Most Holy Name of Jesus - Matthew 1:25.
- 4: Simeon's prophecy that many would be rise - Luke 2:34.
- 5: The Overthrow of idols Isaiah - 19:1.
- 6: Life with Mary and Jesus - Luke 2:39.
- 7: Finding Jesus in the Temple - Luke 2:46.

Specially commissioned **miniature St Joseph's Cinctures** will be available for a £4.50 donation; you can reserve one by contacting Maggie at the Parish Office and payment can be made after Mass on 1st May (when they will be blessed using the official formula).
