The First Millennial Saint: Blessed Carlo Acutis:

The fact that a millennial teenager is to become a saint is truly wonderful news and it has caught the attention of the world's secular press. There is something about the life of Carlo, a saint of our times, that makes everyone excited. For all those who felt heaven was out of reach, Blessed Carlo has brought great hope. Carlo was an ordinary boy, but because he tried to live for God, the Lord has raised him to the heights of holiness. Blessed Carlo had a simple "roadmap" to heaven that each one of us can follow - **1: Mass. 2: Eucharistic Adoration. 3: Devotion to Our Lady and the Saints. 4: Confession and Spiritual Guidance. 5: Acts of charity.** Everyone deserves to know how they too can spend eternity with the God who created them and loves them; do tell other people about this soon-to-be-saint. **Blessed Carlo prayer cards** are available at the back of the Church so that you, your family and your friends can seek his heavenly intercession. Carlo was born in London in 1991 and died in Milan in 2006; at his request his body was transferred to Assisi in 2007. Carlo was declared a Blessed in October 2020 and is likely to be decreed a Saint during the 2025 Holy Year.
