#### Carlo's Acutis 5-Step Plan to Holiness

**1: Holy Mass.** Carlo strove to go to Mass each day for he knew it is the foundation for having an intimate relationship with Jesus. He knew that Holy Mass was a foretaste of heaven and thus he had an ardent love for the Real Presence of Christ in Holy Communion. Carlo wanted everyone to know the intimacy of receiving Jesus in Holy Communion; so much so that he used his computer skills to

share with the world the miracle of "transubstantiation". At only eleven years old Carlo researched eucharistic miracles and even visited many of the places where they occurred; this was the basis of his website and exhibition. It was his profound love for the Mass that inspired Carlo's parents to return to the Catholic Faith and for his Hindu nanny to convert to Christ. Carlo longed to worthily receiving Jesus each day at Mass. When the Acutis family travelled, the first place that Carlo would look for was the Church and the time of Mass. After receiving Holy Communion for the first time, he encouraged his family to consecrate itself to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. His reasoning was profound: "**The Eucharist is truly the Heart of Jesus.**" Carlo couldn't fathom why sports stadiums were full of people and yet churches were empty and thus he would repeatedly say: "They have to see; they have to understand." To understand the intimacy with which Jesus comes to us in Holy Communion is astonishing, especially in such a young person. A key to understanding Carlo's deep eucharistic spirituality was his devotion to St John, the beloved disciple of Jesus. At the Last Supper, this young disciple leans on Jesus' breast and he receives the Priesthood from the Lord with power to renew the sacrifice of the Holy Cross at each celebration of the Mass: "Do this in memory of me". Carlo's commentary on the disciple John is an invitation to draw close to Jesus: "It's fantastic: like St John, all are called to become beloved disciples. All we need is to become eucharistic souls, adoring souls, allowing God to work those wonders in us, which only he can do. But he wants our will to submit freely. God does not like forcing anyone. He desires our freely given love." **Blessed Carlo Acutis: Pray for us!**
