### Carlo's Acutis 5-Step Plan to Holiness

**4: Confession and Spiritual Guidance.** Carlo's desire for holiness was clearly demonstrated by his desire to regularly celebrate the Sacrament of Confession and to have a Spiritual Director. "If only I had had a spiritual director from the beginning" wrote St Faustina Kowalska "then I would not have wasted so many of God's graces". Every month Carlo would make a journey of between 135

miles and 160 miles, thus taking several hours, to see his Spiritual Director. Carlo knew that to grow in holiness and to become a saint in the next life requires discipline, prayer, humility, our free cooperation with the grace we receive from the Sacraments and by reading the Sacred Scriptures and through acts of charity (the Corporal Works of Mercy). As Carlo would say: "Only the one who does the will of God will be truly free". Toward the end of each meeting with his Spiritual Director Carlo would request to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation; as Carlo would say: "The only thing that we must really fear is sin". Carlo celebrated the Sacrament of Confession every week and thus profoundly asked: "Why do people worry so much about the beauty of their own body and not about the beauty of their soul?" Carlo was not afraid to confront his own sins and faults, be that gluttony, distraction in prayer, daydreaming in school, etc. Carlo truly trusted in God's infinite mercy. In his bedroom, he kept an image of the Divine Mercy Jesus and a small statue of the Infant Jesus of Prague. He lived through the Great Jubilee Year of 2000 and thus Carlo involved his parents in praying the Novena of Mercy that was given by Jesus Himself to St Faustina Kowalska. As Blessed Carlo taught: "In order to rise up high, a hot air balloon needs to shed weight, just like the soul, which, in order to raise itself up to heaven, needs to remove those small weights, called venial sins. If by chance, there is a mortal sin, the soul falls to the ground. Confession is like the fire underneath the balloon, enabling the soul to rise again...It is important to go to confession often, because the soul is very complex". **Blessed Carlo: Pray for us!**
