→ The petition slips attached to this newsletter can be placed in the container in front of the Altar after Mass.

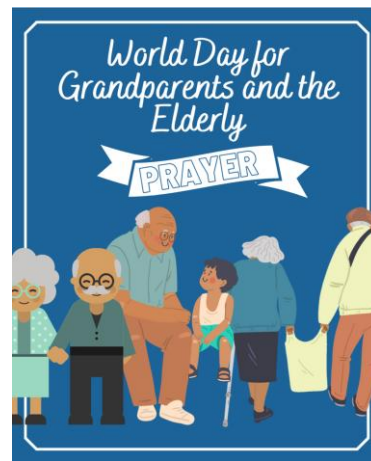
### Petitions Box:
