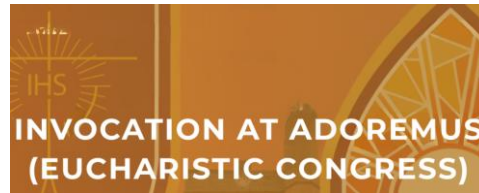


Marriage & Family Life Mass

Walsingham Association - A Parish Group:

As many of us know, Walsingham is a unique Marian Shrine of the Incarnation, where pilgrims can share in Mary’s great joy at the Annunciation (Luke 1: 26-38). As a community we are truly blessed beyond measure to live out our sacramental life in a Church dedicated to Our Lady of Walsingham: thus, having a tangible link with the National Shrine and a concrete sharing in Mary’s joy. We would like to celebrate and develop the link between the Shrine and our own parish by forming a cell of the Walsingham Association; we are in communication with the Shrine to see if they would support the establishment of such a link. Initially, our journey will begin with praying the Rosary in Church each Wednesday after the 9:30am Mass, commencing on 4th September. Our focus will be to honour Mary as the Mother of God, to seek her intercession for the needs of the Church and world, to pray for the work of the Catholic Shrine and to offer the intentions in our “Holy House” petitions box.
