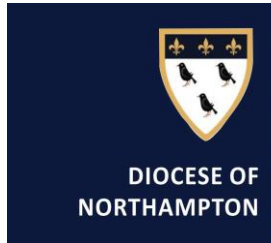

The Seven Sorrows of Our Lady are the:

1. Prophecy of Simeon (Luke 2:34-35).
2. Flight into Egypt (Matthew 2:13-21).
3. Loss of Jesus for three days (Luke 2:41-50).
4. Sight of Jesus carrying the Cross (John 19:17).
5. Crucifixion of Jesus (John 19:18-30).
6. Deposition of Jesus from the Cross (John 19:39-40).
7. Burial of Jesus (John 19:39-42).

→ Each Monday of September we will offer The Seven Sorrows of Our Lady devotion: details in the calendar.

✦ Due to its “doctrinal and pastoral importance” the Church encourages devotion to **Our Lady of Sorrows** as this “emphasises the association of Mary with the saving Passion of her Son”. Therefore, for September the image of Our Lady of Grace in OLW has been veiled in Mary’s “black mantle of sorrow”.
