**The Dedication of a Church:** We are asked by the Church to commemorate the anniversary of the day on which the Church was dedicated. This can happen in several different ways and for us it will take place on the weekend of 26<sup>th</sup>/27<sup>th</sup> October in both parishes.

**Attached to this newsletter** are petition slips that we hope you will return and place in a petitions box on or before 27<sup>th</sup> October as a prayerful way of marking the anniversary of the dedication of each Church. You could use the petition slips to pray in thanksgiving for the clergy and religious who have served the parishes, for deceased parishioners, hopes for the future, etc.

**All Saints Day (1<sup>st</sup> November)** is a Holy Day of Obligation and therefore every Catholic is obligated to attend Mass on that day. Holy Mass will be offered on:

- Thursday, 31<sup>st</sup> October in Our Lady of Walsingham Church at 6:30pm. The Rosary will be at 6:00pm.
- Friday, 1<sup>st</sup> November in St John Ogilvie Church at 9:00am. The Sacrament of Confession and the Holy Rosary will be offered after Mass.

NB: On All Saints Day the Friday rule from abstaining from eating meat is lifted.
