New Translation of the Lectionary:

From the First Sunday of Advent (1st December) we shall be using, along with all parishes in England and Wales, the new translation of the lectionary. This is a good moment to refresh our minds and hearts that:

- The First, and Second Reading if there is one, ends with: "The word of the Lord. Thanks be to God."
- The reader won't say: "The response to the Psalm is..." but will say the response and we repeat it.
- The reader won't say: "We stand for the Gospel".
- In the Bidding Prayers the reader will pause after each intention so that we might pray and will end the silence with: "Lord in your mercy" or similar.
