2024/2025 SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION:

Parents are asked to ensure that their child or children can confidently offer the following:

- All the said or sung responses at Mass.
- Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory be, the *Angelus* (traditionally recited by all Catholics at 6:00am, 12:00noon and 6:00pm or around these times).
- Liturgical gestures, e.g. the Sign of the Cross, striking our chest during the *Confiteor*, kneeling, bowing during the Creed, etc.

New Translation of the Lectionary:

We are now using, along with all parishes in England and Wales plus Scotland, the new translation of the lectionary; this is a good moment to be reminded that:

- The First, and Second Reading if there is one, ends with: "The word of the Lord. Thanks be to God."
- The reader won't say: "The response to the Psalm is..." but will say the response and we repeat it.
- At the Gospel the reader will not say: "The Gospel Acclamation" or "We stand for the Gospel".
- In the Bidding Prayers the reader will pause after each petition so that we might silently pray.
