Jubilee Year Parish Devotions:

Bishop David will grant an indulgence to those who participate in any of the below parish devotions:

- **Spiritual Adoption Novena for the Unborn Child:** This begins on Tuesday, 25th March (Annunciation) and will conclude on Sunday, 28th December.
→ *A chaplet of beads on which to pray this devotion will be available soon for only £2.00; this is the cost of production, and it includes a 50p donation toward projects in the 'Holy House'; details next weekend.*

- **The Canonisation of Blessed Carlo Acutis:**

Offered in thanksgiving for Carlo's Canonisation on Sunday, 27th April there will be a novena of prayer for the youth of our parishes; this begins on Sunday, 4th May and will conclude on Monday, 12th May.

- **An Afternoon with the Blessed Virgin Mary:**

This will take place on Saturday, 31st May (Visitation) and will be a special opportunity to deepen our love for Our Lady. See the notice overleaf for details and please promote this among your family and friends.

- **Ten Virtues of the Blessed Virgin Mary Chaplet:** Starting on Thursday, 7th August and concluding on Friday, 15th August (Solemnity of the Assumption).

The Northampton Notre Dame Association:

In the eighteenth century the Sisters of Notre Dame (founded by St Julie Billiart) arrived in Northampton and started a school for girls; this closed in 1975. A Mass of Thanksgiving is to be offered in Northampton Cathedral on Saturday, 19th July at noon (followed by refreshments) and all former Notre Dame pupils are invited and are also asked to publicise this gathering.
