This is an obligatory day of: **Abstinence** from eating meat for all aged fourteen and above. **Fasting** for those who are aged eighteen to fifty-nine.

Palm Cross: If you return your old palm cross, to the box in Church, these will be burned, ground down and the resulting 'powder' used on Ash Wednesday.

Jubilee Year Shrine Churches:

Bishop David has designated three Churches as shrines for the Jubilee Year where a person can obtain the Holy Year Indulgence: *The Holy Child and St Joseph in Bedford, St Peter's in Marlow and our Cathedral in Northampton. St Brendan & St Patrick's parish are to visit the Cathedral and St Edward's parish (Kettering) are to visit Marlow. *If making a summer pilgrimage to Bedford would be of interest, please let us know.* *This is home to the Relic Image of Our Lady of Guadalupe.

Jubilee Year Parish Devotion:

• **Spiritual Adoption Novena for the Unborn Child:**

This lasts for nine months (from Tuesday, 25th March to Sunday, 28th December) and involves praying one decade of the Rosary every day accompanied by a daily prayer. While you can use your own rosary, you can purchase a single chaplet for £2:00 (which is cost price and includes a 50p donation for projects in the Holy House). Each chaplet is individually made using white glass beads to symbolise the innocent soul of the unborn child. The chaplet includes a crucifix, the Our Father bead and a central medal depicting the Holy Family (whose prayers we seek to protect the life of the unborn child) and on which is prayed both the Glory Be and Fatima prayers.
