## Open Gathering with Bishop David:

*New Wineskins Discernment Process.* Bishop David is asking all Pastoral Areas to reflect on their community life and mission into the future. This includes our priestly provision, property and finance, together with all that we need to be outward-looking, flourishing and resilient Catholic communities. The process begins in our Pastoral Area with an open gathering with Bishop David on Tuesday, 18<sup>th</sup> March at 7:00pm (to 9:00pm) in St Brendan's Church and everyone is welcome to attend. Its purpose is to listen to as many different voices and experiences as possible and **you** are invited to join the conversation. At this gathering our Pastoral Area Representative (Kirsty Swallow for St John Ogilvie Church & Eamonn McCauley for Our Lady of Walsingham Church) will offer three positives and challenges about each parish. **You** can contribute to the discussion by suggesting three positives and three challenges (not negatives!) to Kirsty or Eamonn, e.g.:

- *Positive:* Refreshments after 5:00pm Sunday Mass.
- *Challenge:* Meeting the spiritual needs of youth.
- *Positive:* The "Thursday Ladies" Cleaners Group.
- *Challenge:* Encouraging louder responses at Mass.
