New Wineskins Discernment Process. Bishop David is asking all Pastoral Areas (PA) to reflect on the need to be outward-looking, flourishing and resilient Catholic communities. For us this process begins with an open gathering with Bishop David on Tuesday, 18th March - **please note the changes** - in St Brendan's School from 7:30pm to 9:00pm. Be a part of this conversation! At this meeting our PA Representatives (Kirsty Swallow for St John Ogilvie Church and Eamonn McCauley for Our Lady of Walsingham Church) will present both the three positives and the three challenges about our parishes that you have offered to them.

Spiritual Adoption Novena for the Unborn Child:

- **New:** There are three ways you can participate in the novena and you can choose which best suits you:
 - 1) Pledge to praying it daily for nine months.
 - 2) Commit to praying it as often as you can.
 - 3) Dedicate yourself to praying, as often as you are able, for those who are offering the full novena. It means that you can still be a part of the novena regardless of the commitment level you can make.
