## **CHANGES IN CORBY**

At the Pastoral Area open meeting (held on Tuesday, 18<sup>th</sup> March at St Brendan's Primary School), Bishop David announced that Fr Christopher has been asked to take on additional responsibilities in the Diocese as part of his on-going role as one of the Episcopal Vicars. To fulfil his new responsibilities Fr Christopher will be appointed to a smaller parish in the Diocese, hopefully a little closer to Northampton. As a result of this move Fr Mark has been asked by the Bishop to become the Parish Priest of all three Parishes in Corby and an additional Priest will be appointed to assist him in the sacramental and pastoral work of our community. The timescale for this is not finalised but it is anticipated that **Fr Christopher will move during the summer**. In addition, Fr Wayne will also be leaving Corby. This is an exciting time for the Catholic community in Corby with new opportunities and initiatives on the horizon. A listening process has begun so that everyone can be involved in shaping the Catholic mission of parishes in this part of the Diocese. Please keep Bishop David and all our Priests in your prayers, who in turn extend their prayerful appreciation for your kindness and support.

## **Spiritual Adoption Novena for the Unborn Child:**

  - 1) Pledge to pray it daily for nine months.

- **Public enrolment** into the novena will take place at this weekend's Sunday Masses and at Holy Mass on Monday, 24<sup>th</sup> March. NB: **Private enrolment** into the novena will be offered after the Vigil Mass: 22/03/25.
