Changes in Corby

At the Pastoral Area meeting (on Tuesday, 18th March) Bishop David announced that Fr Christopher has been asked to take on new responsibilities in the Diocese as part of his on-going role as one of the Episcopal Vicars. To fulfil this Fr Christopher will now be appointed to a smaller parish in the Diocese. Consequently, Fr Mark has been asked by the Bishop to become the Parish Priest of all three Corby parishes and an additional Priest will assist him in the sacramental and pastoral work of our community. The timescale for this is not finalised but it is anticipated that **Fr Christopher will move during the summer**. In addition, Fr Wayne will also be leaving Corby. This is an exciting time for the Catholic community in Corby with new opportunities and initiatives on the horizon. A listening process has begun so that everyone can be involved in shaping the Catholic mission of parishes in this part of the Diocese.
