Petition Slips:

Q: What happens with my prayer petition slip?

A: These are collectively prayed for at the Wednesday Rosary in the Holy House and at the Holy Rosary on a Saturday. Generic intentions from the petition slips form the basis for the Wednesday Rosary. In addition, Mass is offered for these intentions and a parishioner prays for every intention that is left.

Carlo Acutis Novena:

Celebrating the canonisation of Carlo Acutis, this will commence on Sunday, 4th May at 9:45am. A leaflet about this novena and a children's activity sheet are available on our website (see the newsletter section). **Well done!** The Bishops have asked parishes to share with them their plans to celebrate the canonisation of Carlo Acutis. It was wonderful to be able to tell them of the two leaflets that were distributed at Mass last Sunday, the forthcoming novena, the instillation of a temporary shrine, the distribution of petition slips on 27th April (which can be returned with the names of our children on so that we can pray for them) and a very special Children's Liturgy of the Word on 4th May.

Do remember that:

- 1) You can host an image of Carlo Acutis in your own home for a day during the novena; see the leaflet distributed last weekend for more details.
- 2) An indulgence is associated with this novena.
