2. **Revised prayers** for the parish Carlo Acutis Novena: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, ✠ and of the Holy Spirit. Amen

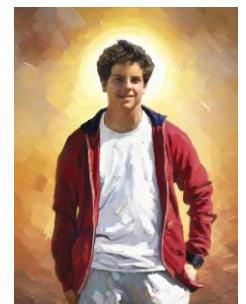
