

will be declared a saint by Pope Leo on **Sunday, 7th September**. To celebrate this truly historic occasion temporary shrines will be added to both Churches and petition slips made available so that we can ask "St" Carlo to pray for us and for our intentions.

The Knights of St Columba have arranged for the **relics of St Andrew, St Columba and St Margaret** to visit Our Lady of Walsingham Church between 14th and 16th July. The purpose of the visit is to allow us to connect with the spiritual legacy of these saints and to deepen our Faith. There will be opportunities to venerate the relics, to offer the Rosary at the relics and to invoke the prayers of these saints through using petition slips; further details will be in next weekend's newsletter. There will be a **Reception of Relics Mass** on **Monday, 14th July at 6:30pm** in Our Lady of Walsingham Church.



Travelling Home Shrine:

At the Vigil, 8:30am and 10am Sunday Masses, new **Our Lady of Walsingham travelling home shrines**, will be blessed! Each home shrine was made by former Bedford parishioners of Fr Wayne and include two Marian prayer books and a bag. Wonderfully, a rosary (made by Janet Northing, using glass and gemstone beads) hang on each side of the home

shrine; the hope is that the person hosting this will invite a friend to pray the rosary with them. We ask that after each of the above Masses one person takes responsibility for having the shrine in their home and will then directly offer it to other parishioners over the coming weeks.
