First Reconciliation, First Holy Communion & Confirmation Preparation in AD 2025/2026:

From Fr Mark Floody. "We are going to follow the practice recommended by the diocese for children for First Holy Communion and Confirmation to be prepared within the parish by parish catechists and supported by the clergy. So, for the children who are looking to celebrate the sacraments next year we will prepare them, those in Catholic Schools and those in State Schools, within the parish. This will consist of one Saturday morning a month and the classes will be held at St Patrick's Primary School. We will give dates and times in the next few weeks. I know this is a major change and we will be asking the families to commit to the programs, but it is also a wonderful way for the children to get to know each other throughout the parishes in Corby." Spiritual Adoption Novena: This began just under eighteen weeks ago and is being prayed for babies in the womb, known by God, who are threatened by abortion. At eighteen weeks the baby is about 14.2cm long from head to bottom, so they are approximately the size of a bell pepper. The baby's ears, nose, and lips are all recognisable on an ultrasound. Eyebrows, eyelashes, nails and hair are formed too. The small tubes in the lungs have started to develop and girl/boy parts are formed and in place. The baby will be doing a lot of wriggling which means that the mother will feel the baby moving around for the first time. The baby may begin a sleep-wake cycle, so loud noises may wake the baby up if they are asleep!
