**HOLY HOUR:** We will have [Holy Hour on a Monday evening at 5.45pm at St Brendan's when there is an evening Mass.](#) It will give us an opportunity to pray before the Blessed Sacrament, especially praying for vocations to the priesthood and the consecrated life.

**NOVEMBER, A SPECIAL MONTH OF PRAYER FOR OUR DEAD:** We remember our loved ones who have died every day but November is a special month of remembrance. We will have the Masses for All Souls Day which is on Monday 3rd November this year.
