NOVEMBER, THE MONTH OF PRAYER FOR OUR DEAD:

We remember our loved ones who have died every day but November is a special month of remembrance. We will have the Masses for All Souls Day which is on Monday 3rd November this year. We will then have Masses at St Brendan's on 10th November 7.00pm and Our Lady's on 12th November at 7.00pm when we will read out the names of those who have died over the last year and whose funerals were officiated by the priests in the three parishes. The names of those whose funerals took place at St John Ogilvie's will be read at the Mass at Our Lady's. For our beloved dead we pray that they may rest in peace.

NOVEMBER LISTS FOR THE DEAD. Whilst we remember our beloved dead every day, November is a special month when we remember them in a special way and entrust them to the loving embrace of God. We have put out the envelopes for you to put in your lists and will place them in a box in front of the altar and pray for them everyday during the month of November.
