PARISH LISTENING PROCESS: Following this initiative in our parishes, a Discernment Group was formed to reflect on the feedback shared by parishioners. Our North Northamptonshire Pastoral Area - which includes Corby, Kettering, Wellingborough, Rushden, Thrapston, Oundle and Raunds - is more geographically dispersed than most, and as a result we are discerning the future at different paces. This is natural, as each of our communities has its own particular strengths and challenges. The Corby Discernment Group, made up of representatives from our three parishes, has been exploring a range of possible ways forward. In the New Year, we will hold an open meeting to which everyone will be invited, so that we can share proposals and discuss how our mission in Corby can continue to grow, thrive and respond to both the challenges and opportunities ahead.
