BAPTISM OF THE LORD: Today marks the end of the Christmas season with the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord which marks the beginning of the Lord's public ministry. At Christmas and the Epiphany Jesus was revealed as the light of the world, the Messiah and the Father's voice and the presence of the Holy Spirit descending upon him like a dove affirms his identity, the fulfilment of the promise God made with his people. As we reflect on our own baptism today we are reminded of the public dimension of our own calling, to reveal and live the Gospel of Jesus Christ and play our part in the mission of the Church.

LITURGY COMMISSION - The God Who Speaks, Our Liturgy of the Word: A series of online Zoom sessions offered by the Diocese of Northampton Liturgy Commission (Liturgical Formation), exploring the upcoming Lectionary readings and the seasons of the Liturgical Year.

These sessions provide a valuable opportunity to deepen engagement with the Scriptures proclaimed at the Liturgy of the Word at Mass. Led by the Liturgical Formation Team, with contributions from Fr Andrew Behrens, Liz Clark, Deacon Peter Collins, Fr Jaismon Francis MSFS, Fr Allan Jones CRIC, and Mgr Kevin McGinnell, each session runs from 7.30–8.30pm and includes prayer, input, and time for questions and discussion.

PARISH LISTENING PROCESS: Following this initiative in our parishes, a Discernment Group was formed to reflect on the feedback shared by parishioners. Our North Northamptonshire Pastoral Area - which includes Corby, Kettering, Wellingborough, Rushden, Thrapston, Oundle and Raunds - is more geographically dispersed than most, and as a result we are discerning the future at different paces. This is natural, as each of our communities has its own particular strengths and challenges. The Corby Discernment Group, made up of representatives from our three parishes, has been exploring a range of possible ways forward. In the New Year, we will hold an open meeting to which everyone will be invited, so that we can share proposals and discuss how our mission in Corby can continue to grow, thrive and respond to both the challenges and opportunities ahead. Details will be provided in the coming weeks.
