CHANGE IN SCHEDULE: Fr Mark will be the only priest in Corby for at least 3 weeks so there will have to be a change in the schedule during this period. He asks for your understanding and patience. The 6 Saturday evening and Sunday Masses will remain but there will be no Mass on Friday or Saturday morning to give Fr Mark time to prepare for the weekend (these Mass intentions will be added in with the other week-day intentions). This will be reviewed after 4 weeks. Confessions will now be held at Our Lady's after Monday morning Mass and at St Brendan's on a Monday evening at 6.00pm. You can also make an appointment to see Fr Mark if you want Confession at another time. Just bear with us as we make these adjustments. Please keep Fr Liam in your prayers.

N.B. CHANGES TO THE MASS SCHEDULE THIS WEEK: Please note there are Services of Word and Communion on Monday and Saturday mornings. Mass on Monday evening is at 6.00pm, and Mass on Tuesday morning at 9.15am.

DISCERNMENT PROCESS - NEW WINE SKINS: Fr Mark would like to thank everyone who attended the open Parish Meetings last Monday, it was good to see so many at the talks. He outlined the different scenarios that were looked at, the financial implications and all the work that needs to be carried out on the 3 churches so they comply with health & safety requirements as well as essential maintenance. In the first year we were looking at around £170,000 for essential work and over a five year period that figure rises to nearly £500,000. This is not sustainable. Sadly the discernment team, made up of representatives from the 3 parishes, concluded that the scenario we should consider is to close St John Ogilvie's and equip Our Lady's and St Brendan's for the future ministry in Corby, a town that has grown dramatically over the last 30 years and is continuing to grow. This is not managing decline, far from it. We have every confidence that the Church will grow in Corby and we may need to look at opening a mission in the newly developed areas, depending of course on priestly provision. We have the next open parish meeting on Monday 9th February at 7pm at St Brendan's where we can discuss how we make the changes and listen to any suggestions you may have.
