THE NEW ENCYCLICAL: Pope Leo XIV has issued his first encyclical, *Magnifica humanitas*, calling on the world to place the dignity of the human person at the centre of the rapidly developing age of artificial intelligence. Released by the Vatican on Monday, 25 May 2026, the encyclical, whose title translates as “The Greatness of Humanity”, reflects on the opportunities and dangers presented by AI, while reaffirming the Church’s enduring commitment to human dignity, solidarity, justice, and the common good. The document bears the Pope’s signature dated 15 May, marking the 135th anniversary of *Rerum novarum*, the landmark encyclical of Pope Leo XIII widely regarded as the foundation of modern Catholic social teaching. That historic document addressed the social and economic upheaval brought about by the industrial revolution. In *Magnifica humanitas*, Pope Leo XIV draws a parallel with the technological revolution unfolding today.

ORDINATION TO THE PRIESTHOOD: Please keep Deacon Chris in your prayers as he prepares for his ordination to the priesthood on 20th June at Northampton Cathedral. Deacon Chris would have loved to invite many parishioners to share in this special occasion. Unfortunately, due to limited space within the cathedral, attendance at the ordination is by invitation only. A number of representatives from both churches will be attending on behalf of the parish community. Chris will celebrate Mass on 28 June at Our Lady's at 9:30am and at St Brendan's at 11:30am. Refreshments will follow in St Brendan's School Hall, and all are warmly invited to join the celebrations. Please continue to pray for Deacon Chris during this final stage of preparation for his priestly ordination.

Change of Mass times for Sunday, 28th of June: As a result of the above notice, Mass at Our Lady's for that weekend is at 9.30 am. This will give more time for Rev Chris to greet people at Our Lady's before he goes to celebrate Mass at St Brendan's.

DEACON CHRIS: We are looking forward to Deacon Chris' ordination to the priesthood on 20th June. Many people have asked what they might give him as a gift, and we know it can be difficult to decide. To make things easier, there will be a collection for Deacon Chris this week. You may contribute by putting a labelled envelope in the collection, place your gift in a labelled envelope and hand it in to the parish office, or donate via the Dona Station, where there will be a category for Deacon Chris' Ordination Gift. We will present the gift to him at the reception following his Mass at St Brendan's on 28th June. Please remember to keep Deacon Chris in your prayers.

YOUTH/YOUNG ADULTS GROUP: We are delighted to have begun a Young Adults Group in the parish for those aged 18-35. The group focuses on fellowship, faith-sharing, and growing together in Christ, and it has already been wonderful to gather as a community of young people in the parish. Due to Deacon Chris preparing for his ordination and the commitments during the month of June, the next young adults meeting will resume in July.

SCHOOL EXAMS: Please remember in your prayers all the children preparing for their exams in the coming weeks. May the Lord bless them with calmness, confidence, and the ability to do their very best.

CONFIRMATION: The dates and times for Confirmation is Saturday, 27th June. As last year, there will be two services — 11.00am at St Brendan's and 2.00 pm at Our Lady's. Confirmation will be celebrated within a Service of the Word to allow Fr Mark time to celebrate each service and to prepare for the two parish evening Masses. A letter is available at the back of the church for parents and carers of children preparing for their First Holy Communion and Confirmation. **Please make sure to collect and keep this letter, as it contains important information about rehearsal dates and times (which candidates must attend), as well as further details about the services.**

RCIA: It was wonderful to welcome the new members of the parish at the Easter Vigil. Moving forward, we will be holding informal sessions after Mass on Monday evenings, giving our new members an opportunity to meet together as we continue to support them on their journey of faith. Anyone interested in learning more about the Catholic faith is also very welcome to join us. The formal RCIA programme will begin in September. **Please note there will be no meeting this Monday.**
