ORDINATION TO THE PRIESTHOOD: Please keep Deacon Chris in your prayers as he prepares for his ordination to the priesthood on 20th June at Northampton Cathedral. It will be a great blessing for the diocese to celebrate the ordination of a new priest. After his ordination, Deacon Chris will celebrate Mass at St Brendan’s in Corby on the following weekend, on 28th June at 11:30am, with refreshments served afterwards in the school hall. Pray for Deacon Chris in this final stage of preparation for his priestly ordination.

YOUTH/YOUNG ADULTS GROUP: We are delighted to have begun a Young Adults Group in the parish for those aged 18-35. The group focuses on fellowship, faith-sharing, and growing together in Christ, and it has already been wonderful to gather as a community of young people in the parish. Due to Deacon Chris preparing for his ordination and the commitments during the month of June, the next young adults meetings will resume in July.

PILGRIMAGE TO WALSINGHAM: The annual diocesan pilgrimage to Walsingham is on Saturday 13th June. It will begin at midday with Mass at the National Shrine, before pilgrims gather outside the Chapel of Reconciliation for a procession along the Pilgrim route to the Priory grounds, where there will be a short service at the site of the original Holy House.

OUR LADY’S TO OUR LADY PILGRIMAGE FOR SVP: Help Robert Dunne raise money to support the SVP. SVP: The SVP run a foodbank as sadly those who are in need grows all year round. All our food parcels are distributed to those who need them in our Catholic Schools and parishes, here is a list of items in most need: tinned spaghetti, tinned tomatoes, pasta sauce, rice, tinned vegetables, tinned meat, tinned fish, tinned fruit, tinned custard and rice pudding, breakfast cereals, biscuits, coffee, long life juice, UHT milk, disposable razors, shampoo, deodorant, shower gel, toilet rolls, toothpaste. If you can donate, please leave your items with a steward at the back of the church. ALSO, if anyone is struggling with the cost of living, food, fuel etc or you know of anyone, please contact the St Vincent de Paul society, directly or through the Parish office.

PERMANENT DIACONATE: Many of us see deacons serving at the altar, but their call is truly to be a ‘guardian of service’ in the Church. A deacon’s ministry isn’t just within the walls of the church building; it is out in the world – in our workplaces, our hospitals, our schools and with the marginalised within our community. It is a unique vocation for men, many of whom are married and have families, who feel called to serve God through the Word, through service at the Altar, and doing works of charity within the community. If you have ever felt a nudge in your heart to serve more deeply, or if others have told you that you have a ‘servant’s heart’, the Lord may be calling you. For married men, this is a journey shared with your wife, and her support is a vital part of the discernment.
