SVP COACH TO WALSINGHAM: The Corby SVP Pilgrimage for the Sick to Our Lady's Shrine in Walsingham, Norfolk is on Sunday, 2nd July. Coach departure times are St Patrick's Church - 8:00am / St John's - 8:15am / St Brendan's Church - 8:30am and Our Lady's - 8:40am. The coach costs £20 per person; first two children are free and is £5 per child thereafter for each family. Please, if you wish to go add, your name to the list in the porch and make payment to a member or on the coach.

SVP: The SVP run a foodbank as sadly those who are in need grows all year round. All our food parcels are distributed to those who need them in our Catholic Schools and parishes, here is a list of items in most need: tinned spaghetti, tinned tomatoes, pasta sauce, rice, tinned vegetables, tinned meat, tinned fish, tinned fruit, tinned custard and rice pudding, breakfast cereals, biscuits, coffee, long life juice, UHT milk, disposable razors, shampoo, deodorant, shower gel, toilet rolls, toothpaste. If you can donate, please leave your items with a steward at the back of the church. ALSO, if anyone is struggling with the cost of living, food, fuel etc or you know of anyone, please contact the St Vincent de Paul society, directly or through the Parish office.
