FIRST HOLY COMMUNION AND CONFIRMATION PREPARATION

ALSO, if anyone is struggling with the cost of living, food, fuel etc or you know of anyone, please contact the St Vincent de Paul society, directly or through the Parish office.

PALLIATIVE CARE & THE TERMINALLY ILL (END OF LIFE) BILL: Archbishop John Sherrington, Archbishop of Liverpool and Lead Bishop for Life Issues for the Catholic Bishops' Conference of England and Wales, has welcomed the Prime Minister's call for greater investment in palliative and social care ahead of Parliament's consideration of the Terminally Ill Adults (End of Life) Bill. The Bill, which seeks to legalise assisted suicide, is due to return to the House of Commons for its Second Reading on Friday 11 September. Archbishop Sherrington has urged parliamentarians to reject the legislation when it returns to the House of Commons on 11 September, saying: "I once more urge parliamentarians to vote against this dangerous legislation on 11 September and to work together to ensure that our palliative and social care services can be held up as examples of truly dignified care at the end of life for all."

Contact your MP: Ahead of the debate on 11 September, Catholics and [all people of goodwill are encouraged to contact their Member of Parliament](#) and respectfully ask them to vote against the Bill.
